STSMs visit lasting approx. 1-3 months and should end until the end of September

4-5 STSMs in 2023

Please send us 300-400 words outlining the project and data available, anticipated outputs, the timeframe of the STSM, and your (short) CV or website.

We want to fund projects clearly focussing on addressing ecological questions, they should be feasible within the timeframe proposed, and participants should commit to supporting the visitor during and after the STSM to achieve the outputs.
